Plaid to Pay \$58 Million to Settle Data Privacy Class Action

- 11 named plaintiffs to receive \$5,000 each
- 98 million class members to receive \$31.50 each

Plaid Inc. will pay \$58 million in a settlement over allegations that it violated users' privacy rights by scraping their data from third parties, after a federal judge in California granted final approval of the deal.

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
